

## Effective 1 January 2023

The Dalcroze Eurhythmics International Examinations Board (DEIEB), of which Australia is a member, recommends fees payable by candidates for exams. Dalcroze Australia's fees take into account fees charged by other DEIEB members, namely the UK, Canada and Italy. Exam fees cover the cost of staff setting, playing, marking and report writing, venue costs and the issuing of results and Awards.

Fees for Rhythmics exams are based on running the exam for at least three people. Conducting the exam for fewer people may incur a higher fee to cover costs. If a higher fee is necessary, the fee will be confirmed with candidates prior to the exam. Aural and Improvisation exams are also only offered if sufficient numbers register for a given exam session. The Director of Studies reserves the right to decide whether or not to conduct exams.

Conditions apply to the submission of written work. Information available on application. All fees listed are in Australian Dollars.
